ARTICLE XXVII

If any floating light, light-house, buoy, beacon, or other work Removal or tuplaced or to be placed in any part of the said harbor or within its jury to harbor limits, or within the limits of the commissionerss' jurisdiction, or any beacons dredge. dredge lying or in operation in the harbor or roadstead shall be removed, carried away, destroyed or injured by any vessel, raft, or vehicle, or by any person whomsoever, the same shall be replaced or repaired as the case may require, by the master, owner, consignee or person in charge of such raft, vessel, or vehicle, or by such person or persons forthwith and within 48 hours from the time of such removal, destruction or injury, failing which, such master, owner, consignee or person in charge, shall incur the penalty hereinafter fixed for the Penalties. breach of any of these rules and regulations, and a like further penalty for every twenty-four hours during which he shall be in default to conform himself to the provisions hereof, and suall also be bound to pay the said Harbor Commissioners the expenses of such Reparation. replacement or reparation as shall be necessary in the premises
