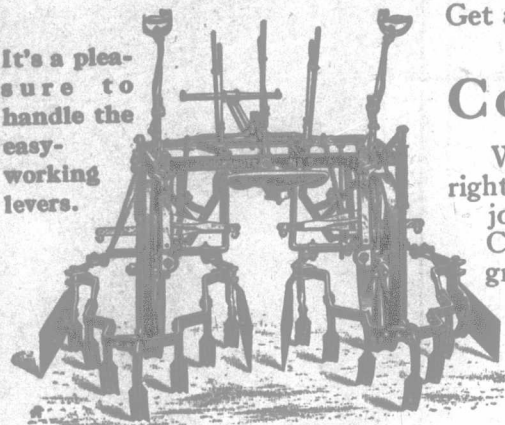


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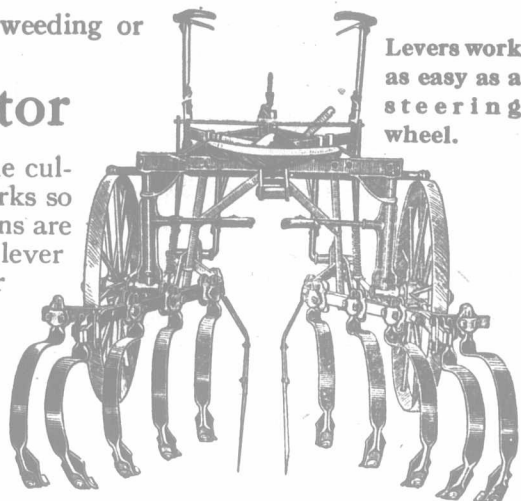
Cockshutt No. 2 Cultivator

Teeth sections are turned either to right or left with slight pressure on a foot lever. Hand levers, assisted by powerful springs, raise or lower them almost without effort.

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
