Assistant principals of large schools receive a \$1,200 maximum. The salaries of the Collegiate institute masters were also advanced so as to be in keeping with the increased cost of living.

This step was undertaken by the trustees thomselves, who realized that in order to keep efficient teachers' on the London staff, it was necessary to make general increases in salaries.
