inspector of branches of the Scotch Act.

who stripped the bark from every tree.

and in several instances either made of-
fers of marriage to women or proposed
to take them to Scotland and educate
them for mission work in China. Yester-
day the police found him dogging families
around Queen's Park and he was arrest-
ed as a vagrant. This morning he
pleaded not guilty before the Police
Magistrate, but subsequently withdrew
the plea. Prisoner was sentenced to
three months in the Central Prison.

LONDON, July 13.—At the regular for-
nightly meeting of the National League
today the treasurer announced that the
donations received from the United States
for the Parliamentarian Fund within the
past two weeks amounted to \$80,000. T.
M. Healy in an address, said although
Irishmen were disappointed at the result
of the elections, they should not be de-
pendent. The defeat, he said, was but
temporary. One million electors had
voted "Home Rule" on their polling
papers as against the unholy existing
triple alliance. A coalition government,
Mr. Healy contended, could not exist
three months.

Exquisite Cake.

A delicious and inexpensive raisin cake
is made of two eggs, one cup and a half
of sugar, two-thirds of a cup of butter,
one cup of sweet milk, two cups and a
half of flour, three teaspoonsful of baking
powder or two teaspoonsful of cream of
tartar and one of soda; one cup of rais-
ins, cloves and cinnamon to suit your
taste, one cup of stoned and chopped
raisins. It is the experience of most
cooks that cake made with cream of tar-
tar and soda will keep moist longer than
that made with baking powder, but the
powder is so convenient to use that it has
almost superseded the other. Do not
frost this cake, but bake until the top is
a dark brown.
