PROCLAMATION

Whereas, a request has been made to the mayor of the City of Toronto to issue a proclamation calling upon the people of the City of Toronto to observe the day of the week, the 1st day of June, 1914, as a day of public mourning for the late King George V.

Whereas, it is considered of importance to the citizens of the city of St. Louis, Missouri, that the prayer of the people be granted;

These will therefore take action in compliance with the said ordinance, do hereby request all citizens to unite their prayers for business and industry to be prospered, on the same day to be convenient, on Friday, the 10th day of September, 1910, at 10 o'clock, a. m.
