3. The Council of the Fruit Growers' Association will retain the privilege of selecting and appropriating any of the fruits exhibited—except potted fruits—that they may wish to send to the Royal Horticultural Society of London.

4. No articles can be removed from the ground until the exhibition is closed, unless by permission of the Committee of Management.
