them, as persons profiting by the change, to shew that the alleged will of the 8th November was the free and uninfluenced act of the testator. Judgment was accordingly given, declaring that the document of the 8th November is not the last will of the deceased. Costs of the plaintiff and the official guardian out of the estate. E. P.
