<u>MFA</u>	Multi-fibre Arrangement.
<u>MFN</u>	Most Favoured Nation.

<u>MTN</u>	Multilateral Trade Negotiations.
<u>NIES</u>	Newly Industrializing Economies. Sometimes referred to as NIC's.
<u>NRBP</u>	Natural Resource Based Products Negotiating Group.
<u>NTB</u>	Non-tariff Barriers (e.g. quotas).
<u>NTM</u>	Non-tariff Measures (e.g. Rules of Origin).
<u>OECD</u>	Organization for Economic Cooperation and Development based in Paris.
<u>OMA</u>	Orderly Marketing Arrangements.
<u>PSE</u>	Producer Subsidy Equivalent.
<u>SAGIT</u>	Sectoral Advisory Groups on International Trade. Thirteen such groups have been established to provide the Canadian government with advice on trade negotiations and on trade-related matters from a sectoral perspective. See also ITAC.
<u>S/CV</u>	Subsidies/Countervail.
<u>TBT</u>	Agreement on Technical Barriers to Trade.
<u>TDE</u>	Trade Distortion Equivalent.
