## ARTICLE IX - COSTS

- The Requested State shall assume all ordinary expenses of executing a request within its boundaries, subject to paragraph 3 of this Article, except
  - (a) fees of experts,
  - (b) expenses of interpretation, translation, transcription and stenographic services,
  - (c) travel and incidental expenses of persons travelling to the Requested State to attend the execution of a request; and
  - (d) costs of counsel appointed with the approval of the Requesting State.
- The Requesting State shall assume all ordinary expenses required to present evidence from the Requested State in the Requesting State, including
  - (a) travel and incidental expenses of witnesses travelling to the Requesting State, including those of accompanying officials; and
  - (b) fees of experts.
- 3. If during the execution of the request it becomes apparent that expenses of an extraordinary nature are required to fulfill a request, the Parties shall consult to determine the terms and conditions under which the request may continue.
- 4. The Parties shall agree, pursuant to Article XVIII, on practical measures as appropriate for the reporting and payment of costs in conformity with this Article.
