BRITISH TRADE MINISTER TO VISIT CANADA

The Minister for International Trade, the Honourable Gerald Regan, announced today that the British Minister for Trade, the Right Honourable Paul Channon, will be visiting Canada from April 30 to May 2. Mr. Channon will meet with Mr. Regan on Wednesday, May 2 in Ottawa to discuss Canada/UK trade and investment issues.

During his visit, Mr. Channon will also meet with Ontario and Quebec officials to discuss British trade and investment in those provinces.

Mr. Channon begins his visit to Canada April 30 in Toronto and will continue to Montreal and Quebec City on May 1 and to Ottawa on May 2.

Great Britain is Canada's third largest trading partner and the leading market for Canadian exports in Europe.
