Mr. Pickersgill laid before the House,—Return to an Address, dated June 26, 1963, to His Excellency the Governor General for a copy of all correspondence between the federal government and the Premiers or other representatives of the several provincial governments regarding the need of there being new fiscal arrangements being entered into and, in particular, any correspondence containing a request for an increase in the share of the provinces in company income tax, personal income tax and succession duties.—(*Notice of Motion for the Production of Papers No. 33*.)

Notices of Motions for the Production of Papers (*Nos. 111, 152, and 157*) having been called were allowed to stand at the request of the government.

On motion of Mr. Knowles for Mr. Orlikow, seconded by Mr. Howard, it was ordered,—That there be laid before this House a copy of all correspondence received since January 1, 1963 by the Prime Minister and/or the Minister of Justice from organizations or individuals dealing with the problem of security procedures and investigations and the replies to same.—(*Notice of Motion for the Production of Papers No. 146*).

On motion of Mr. Caouette, seconded by Mr. Grégoire, it was ordered,—That there be laid before this House a return of the complete results of the general election in Canada on April 8, 1963, showing, for each constituency by provinces, the total votes cast for each candidate.—(*Notice of Motion for the Production of Papers No. 154*).

On motion of Mr. Knowles for Mr. Peters, seconded by Mr. Howard, it was ordered,—That there be laid before this House a copy of all correspondence, reports, documents and replies thereto since January 1, 1961, between the McIntyre Porcupine Mines Ltd., and the Government of Canada or any of its departments, concerning matters related to cost aid paid under the Emergency Gold Mining Assistance Act.—(*Notice of Motion for the Production of Papers No. 156*).

Mr. Choquette, seconded by Mr. Guay, moved,—That an Order of the House do issue for a copy of all correspondence received by the Minister or any of the officials of the Department of Public Works in connection with all works carried out under the jurisdiction of the Department in the constituency of Joliette-L'Assomption-Montcalm since April 1, 1958.—(*Notice of Motion for the Production of Papers No. 158*).

And the question being proposed;

The Honourable the Minister of Public Works (Mr. Deschatelets) stated that he desired a debate on the said motion.

Ordered,—That the said motion be transferred by the Clerk to the order of "Notices of Motions (Papers)" pursuant to Standing Order 47.
