May I say that this breakwater in White Rock, a city which is just north of the international boundary, has been an eyesore to the community for a number of years. Just prior to the election in 1953 a promise was apparently made by the former member to the effect that a breakwater would be given to them for the purpose of housing small boats and preventing their breakup in the event of high seas. The government kept that promise but the breakwater is of very little use. It is much too small and it is too short. The actual expenditure on the breakwater was something like \$150,000.

The suggestion has been made by the department that it is not in the habit of spending money on creating a boat haven or a breakwater for small boats or river craft. In this instance I should like to point out that the city of White Rock itself is a summer resort. It is the best known summer resort on the lower mainland of British Columbia, in fact. There are some 7,000 or 8,000 people resident in the city and on a Sunday it is not at all uncommon to have as many as 30,000 people there. There is a continuous line of traffic from Vancouver, New Westminster and Burnaby into the region. A good number of these people naturally enough own boats. Those boats should be berthed at White Rock which is the natural area in which to spend
