

and be married, £18 per annum : if unmarried, or a widower, £12 per annum. If he have travelled fifteen years, and shall be married, £14 per annum : if unmarried, or a widower, £10 per annum. If he have travelled five years, and be married, £12 per annum : if unmarried, or a widower, £8. If he have travelled long enough to be a Free Member, and yet not entitled to any of the above allowances, and shall be married, £10 : if unmarried, or a widower, £6 10s. per annum.

3. That the widow of a Preacher who has travelled twenty years shall receive, during the time she shall continue the widow of such Preacher, £14 per annum : if fifteen years, £10 per annum ; and if less than fifteen years, yet so long as to be a Free Member, £7 per annum.

4. That every widower, who is a Free Member, and the widow of a Free Member shall receive £3 per annum for every child he or she may be left with, till such child attains the age of ten years.

5. That Preachers' orphan children under one year old, shall be allowed after the rate of £3 per annum, and an advance of five shillings currency per annum shall be made, till they attain the age of twelve years.

### FORM OF A GENERAL DEED OF TRUST.
