CHICAGO, June 3.—Alleged insufficiency of Kansas wheat helped bring about a rally today in wheat. Closing prices were firm at an advance of a shade to 3-8c net. Corn finished 7-8c to 1-4c up, oats with a gain of 1-8c to 1-2c and provisions off 17 1-2c to 2c.
