## [1906-7 BILL.

## An Act in further amendment of The Railway Act, 1903.

IS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:---

**1.** Section 227 of *The Railway Act*, 1903 is repealed, and 1903, s. 58, new s. 229. 5 the following section substituted in lieu thereof:-

"227. No train shall pass over any highway crossing at Rate of rail-level in any thickly-peopled portion of any city, town or cities, etc. village at a greater speed than ten miles an hour, unless such crossing is properly protected, or unless such crossing is con-10 structed and thereafter duly maintained in accordance with

- the orders, regulations and directions of the Railway Committee of the Privy Council and of the Board in force with respect thereto. The Board may limit such speed in any case to any rate that it deems expedient.
- "2. The Company shall have until the first day of January, 15 one thousand nine hundred and eight, to comply with the provisions of this section.'
