The securities offered by the Grand Trunk do not answer this description, altho they are just as good. The government are indisposed to force the company to sell their securities and put up cash, as in the present state of the market this could only be done at a loss. They insist, however, that the securities deposited must be of the value of \$5,000,000. Of course, when communications have to be exchanged between Ottawa and London it takes time, but there is no reason to doubt that the matter will be equitably adjusted in a very little while now: The act, as framed, was very rigidly drawn. If the deposit made does not entirely come within the letter of the law no one will suffer, and parliament can easily ratify the necessary modification.


