Dominions' Big Voice. The conference expresses the opinion hat a readjustment of the constitutional justment, while thoroughly preserving I existing powers of self-government and complete control of domestic affairs, nould be based upon a full recognition the dominions as autonomous nations an imperial commonwealth, and of dian as an important portion thereof; tould recognize the right of the pminions and Indian to a voice in form policy and foreign relations. policy and foreign relations, and uld provide effective arrangements continuous consultation on all im-tant matters of common imperial nterest, and for such concerted actio ounded on that consultation as the several governments shall determine.

Empire Naturalization. The conference recognizes the importance of securing uniformity of Empire policy and action in regard to naturalization, and commends the proposals submitted to the overseas governments by the home office. It recommends that there be no delay in taking steps for the establishment in London of an importal mineral resources bureau. the Empire's metal requirements.

In the view of the experience of the war, the conference draws attention to the importance of developing adequately the capacity for production of naval and military material, munitions and supplies, in all important parts of the Empire including the countries bendester plies, in all important parts of the Empire, including the countries bordering on the Pacific and Indian Oceans, where no such facilities at present exist. It affirms the importance of close co-operation between India, the dominions, and the United Kingdom, with this object in view.

Remedy Income Taxation. The conference urges that the present system of double income taxation within the Empire be taken in hand immediately after the war, and the law so amended to remedy the present unsatisfactory position.

In view of war experience the conference recommends that the safety

In view of war experience the conference recommends that the safety of the Empire and the necessary development of its component parts prompt attentive consideration and concerted action in regard:

First, to the production of adequate food supply and arrangements for its transportation when and where required, under any conditions that may reasonably be anticipated.

Secondly, to the control of natural resources available within the Empire, especially those of an essential character for national purposes, whether in peace or war.

Thirdly, to the economical utilization of such natural resources through manufacturing processes carried on within the Empire; and recommends that the governments concerned consider the enactment of legislation in the same direction.
