

" Society are employed is not to be construed so as to preclude the Executive Committee from making a grant for one of the said missionaries to a separate cure, whether of an old or a new Parish, in any case where they may think such grant to be necessary."

At a meeting of the Executive Committee, April 20, 1855, it was directed that the following *form of Legacy* be printed in the next Report :

" I give to the Diocesan Church Society of Nova Scotia the sum of £——— to be applied to the general purposes of the Society." And the Receipt of the Treasurer of the Society shall be sufficient discharge for the same.

At the General Meeting of the Society, Oct'r 10, 1855, it was directed, " That all donations of £10 and upward be funded, and the interest only applied to the general purposes of the Society."

It was also resolved—

" That the Society will not make its usual grant toward the payment of an Assistant Missionary appointed to a separate cure, unless the people there consent to pay toward the endowment fund of their Parish or Mission, all the proceeds of whatever Glebe Lands may be in that Parish."

At a meeting of the Executive Committee, Oct. 19th, 1855, the following Resolution was adopted :—

" That in future all subscription lists received before the 31st March in each year will appear in the next forthcoming Report, while those received after that date shall be omitted."

At a meeting of the Executive Committee, April 18th, 1856, it was directed :—

" That if Reservations and Special Donations are not mentioned at the time when the contributions are sent in from the Local Committees, the whole amount will be considered as devoted to the general purposes of the Society."

The attention of the Local Committees is particularly requested to the above Resolutions.

At a Meeting of the Executive Committee, in February, 1857, it was Resolved—That in future but one Sermon be preached before the Society at its Annual Meetings, and that the sum of £5 be offered to the Preacher toward defraying his travelling expenses.
