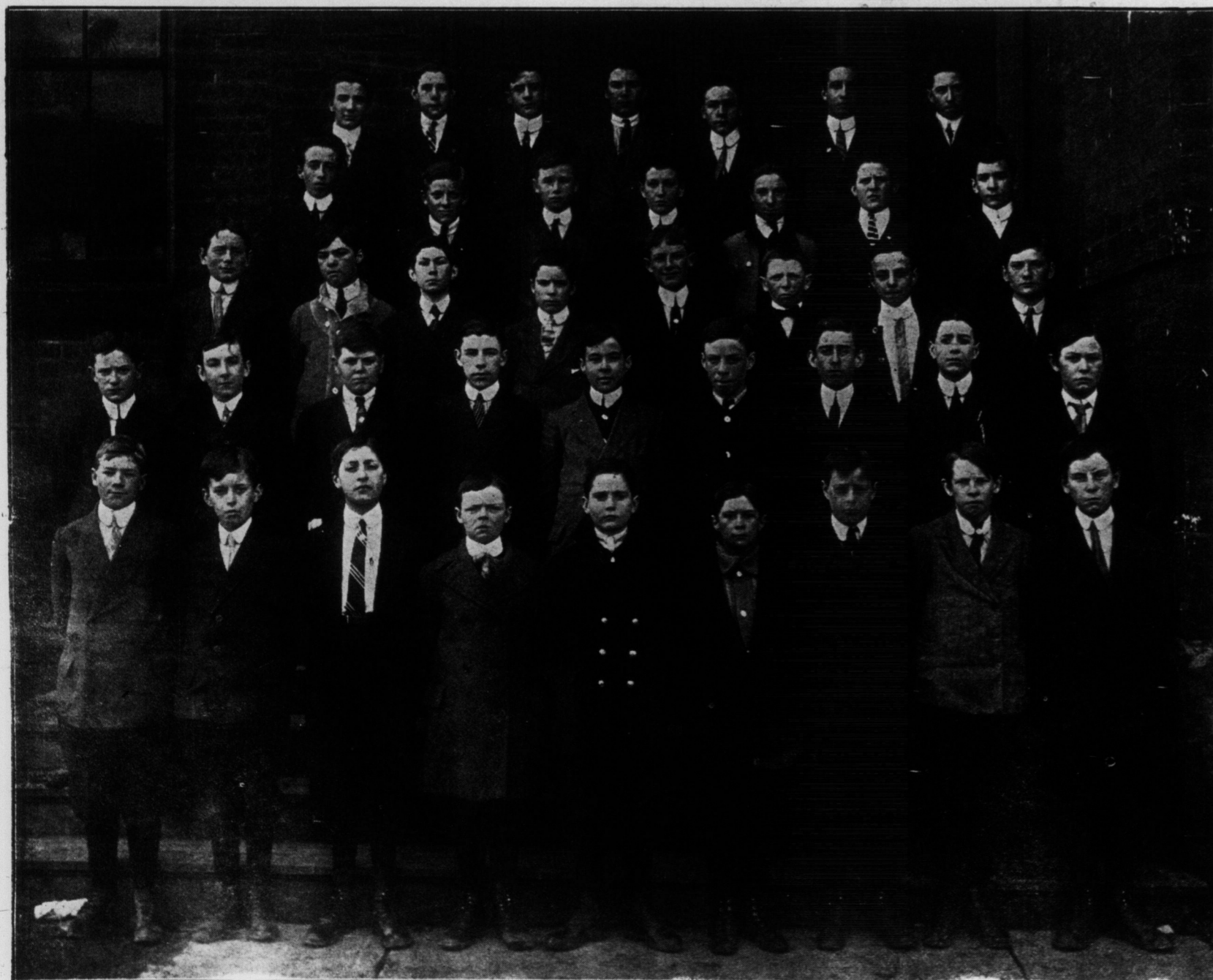

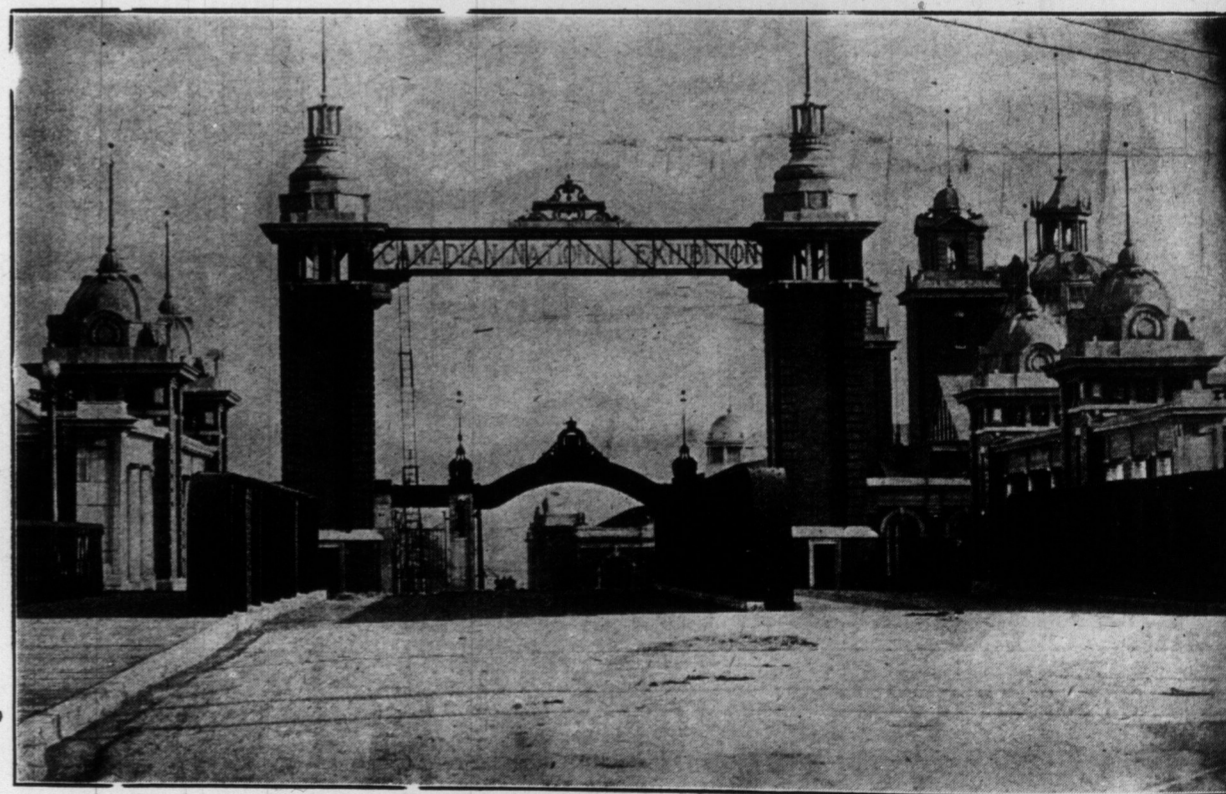

Local theatregoing lovers of clean, wholesome comedy will have one of the treats of the season when the famous comedy "Seven Days" appears at the Grand.
