The amount unpaid for Missionary grants alone, due, but not called for in 1870, was nearly \$1600*; this with several small amounts yet unclaimed would more than exhaust the balance at the end of the year.

INCOME FOR 1871.

The receipts for general purposes up to the present time amount to \$4546.44. The Society can depend upon sufficient yet coming in to make up the Income for 1871 to \$5300.00.

The Committee regret to notice that there are one or two places in which no collections have been made of late, and they suggest that the Society might, perhaps, prevail upon these Parishes not to thus isolate themselves from the general interests of the Church in the Diocese. The Committee cannot but notice that in several other Parishes there is not that hearty co-operation with the work of this Society which its position in the diocese and its impartial administration might justly claim.
