Ten years ago, during 1863, at a time when it was struggling to wipe off a large debt, it contributed \$101, for Missionary and College purposes, a not inconsiderable sum, as things then were. But the total Missionary and Benevolent contributions is fifty fold what it then was, and it may be expected to increase. There are still some names wanting from the list of contributors which should be there, and others that should be guarantees for larger contributions. It is satisfactory to know that in both respects progress is being made.

To the Missionary Collectors the thanks of the congregation are certainly due, for their untiring services. Much depends on their punctuality. Let them receive a hearty welcome to each of our homes, whether the amount we are able to contribute be large or small.
