

ST. CLAIR CIRCUIT AND MISSION.

This work, says Bro. F. M. Finn, is confined, at present, to the Township of Sombra. There are seven regular appointments, 85 members, two chapels, and one parsonage. The friends have been very kind. During the past year a stove was given to the Mission by Bro. Jacob Dingman, and here I would say, if we had four or five more such men as J. Dingman and J. Lampman, we would cease to be pensioners on the missionary funds. There is a fair prospect of this section of country yet being the richest part of Canada. Its inexhaustible fountains of oil are likely to enrich its inhabitants.

BROOKE MISSION.

This Mission embraces the Township of Brooke, and one appointment in Mosa. There are six appointments on the Mission, (all Sabbath) one class, 35 members, one class-leader, seven stewards, and one exhorter. In consequence of unavoidable circumstances, this work is not in as prosperous a condition as it doubtless would have been had not those adverse occurrences taken place. We have no doubt, if properly cultivated, this will, in course of time, become an interesting field of labor. We hope it will be continued, and pray for its prosperity.

ENNISKILLEN MISSION.

This Mission is situated in the Townships of Enniskillen, Plympton, Sarnia and Moore. There are at present five appointments, and a membership of forty-six. There is a good parsonage and lot. This Mission, upon the whole, is of much importance, and I think, says the Rev. C. Burdett, that in a few years, with the blessing of God, it will be a self-sustaining field of labor.

DURHAM DISTRICT.—Rev. W. Woodward, P. E., had supervision.

OSPREY MISSION.

This Mission, says the Rev. R. L. Tindall, has eight appointments, a membership of 78, is situated in a part of country destined to become very valuable for agricultural purposes. There is an efficient quarterly board, three local preachers, two exhorters, and, all things considered, it is certainly worthy of a place on our list of missions. The prospects are encouraging.
