Chicago, May 25.—(A. P.)—Arrangements for nearly 1,000 schoolbooks to compete in its 9th annual interscholastic track meet today and tomorrow, have been made by officials of the University of Chicago. Schools in 26 states last year sent 603 competitors, representing 142 academies and high schools.

This year the meet will be divided into two sections, one for preparatory schools and academies, and the other schools and academies, and the educators are wrecked. Your editorial on this subject, "Seeing Is Believing" somewhat beclouds, and, perhaps inadvertently, misrepresents the case of the educator. You seem to imply that the manufacturers have produced subjects and the educators are backward in using them. Quite the reverse is the case. The educator during the last fifteen or twenty years, to my knowledge, has been appealing to the manufacturer to produce subjects suitable for classroom work, and the manufacturers have failed to respond to the call, chiefly owing to the mistaken idea that they cannot make millions in educational subjects.


