EUROPE'S WHEAT SUPPLY.

The quantity of wheat which the importing countries of Europe will produce this year will be about 100,000,000 sushels less than a year ago, according o a report from Alfred Dennis of the Inited States Department of Commerce, who is making a special investigation of European food conditions. Production of wheat in Europe, which fell to about two-thirds of normal, has shown a gradual increase since 1917, and this year is the first to show a decrease, which may indicate a possible increase in demand on the part of Europe for bread grains.
