

New York, March 1—With 650 uniformed and plain clothes policemen on guard in and around the building, and several hundred more in reserve, Madison Square Garden was packed last night for a meeting of the "Horrors of the Rhine" commitee, called by Dr. 14d-mond Von Mach and other German sympathizers to protest against the alleged use of French colored troops on the Rhine.

Four persons were ejected, three of Pour persons were ejected, three of that body from creating a row.

Sinn Fein enthusiasts joined with the pro-Germans in the celebration. Hearty applause met the suggestion of one speaker that German-Americans and Irish Americans band together "as a majority in the country to banish the phanton of Anglo-Saxonism."

In spite of noisy ovations on the part of a large section of the audience a resolution was adopted calling upon the president of the U. S. to notify the president of France that the American "moral sense" demanded removal of biack troops from the Rhine.

Thousands who could not get into the garden had overflow meetings outside, but ex-service men would not allow the al fresco orators to get a hearing.
