Scheme for Plants to Develop 27,000.000 Horse Power-Lenine Sees in It Future of Soviet Russia.

Viborg, Finland, April 12—(A. P., by mail.)—Communism, plus electrification, is now the slogan of the Russian Soviet regime. Reports of this vast dream of Lenine, by which, say sarcas-tic refugees reaching Finland, he "hopes to make every Russian but a communis-


but only recent Moscow and Petrograd newspapers show the vast extent of the proposed electrification of Russia.

G. S. Zinovieff, Soviet Governor of Petrograd, in a speech at that city, announced that the scheme contemplated the construction all over European Russia and Siberia of huge electric power plants, with a total capacity of 18,170,000 horse-power in the former, and coo,000 horse-power in Siberia. On this work, he said, are to be employed, as fast as possible, the soldiers who are demobilized.




