### HOME ECONOMICS TAUGHT

Traveling Schools and Regular Courses Maintained in Belgium.

Belgium is showing especial interest in home economics teaching for farm girls, according to a representative of the United States Department of Agriculture who visited recently to study the progress of agricultural and home economics work for women abroad.

In the public schools attended by rural girls the work is called agriculture, home economics, and is especially designed to meet the needs of the farm home and also to make farm life attractive by showing its advantages and national importance.

Aside from the regular schools for girls of all ages, there are also traveling schools that offer short courses in home economics, and each province has its home economics council, who works among the girls and women.

The most important of the higher schools in this field is the Superior Normal Institute of Agricultural Home Economics, near Brussels. The large tract of land in which the school stands was presented by the King and includes a farm as well as woods and gardens. The pupils at this school, who are mostly Belgian farm girls, do the work of the place except the heavy field work, dividing their time between theoretical instruction, in household science and practical work, such as cooking, laundry work, butter and cheese making, gar-

## CAETANI TELLS HOW AUSTRIAN ARMY LOST "EYE"

Italian Ambassador Speaks at Dinner Which Closes Convention of Mining and Metallurgical Engineers.

New York, Feb. 27.—The American Institute of Mining and Metallurgical Engineers laid aside the discussion of practical problems to hear Prince Gelasio Caetani, Italian Ambassador to the United States, tell of the mining of the Col di Lana in the Dolomites, the "eye" of the Austrian army, which was captured by the Italians in April, 1918, the day the prince was a national hero. The dinner at the Waldorf, where the story was told, was attended by 2,000. The interest was heightened by the fact that the ambassador is a graduate of the Columbia School of Mines and held his first job as a slag car pumper in the West Mine mine at Park City, Utah.

Prince Caetani's story was one of months of drilling in the rocky interior of the mountains, while the Austrians drove their counter-mines so close that the footsteps of their engineers could be heard sometimes only three feet above the Italian tunnels; months when the danger of a counter-mine being exploded hung constantly over their heads and once materialized, burying five Italians under a fall of rock from the top of the mountain.

The shock, however, was very heavy and part of the ceiling of our tunnel caved, burying an officer and four soldiers. We got them out alive and started again.

Hide and Seek in Mountain.  
The enemy then sank three shafts trying to locate us, but we had gained further depth and passed under their drifts at more than three feet distance. We could hear them walking and dragging bags full of dirt.

"April 15 we loaded five tons of 90 per cent. gelatine in two chambers about thirty feet apart and tamped the galleries. At 10 p. m., April 17, I went up for the last time in the cable and connected the electric wires. I was
