A.118	Lieutenant Morris and I went inside and I took the envelope out of the safe and opened it and counted the money in it, there was forty dollars in it. I gave the money to him and the envelope and he gave me a receipt for it.
Q.119	I show you Exhibit "I". Is that the Receipt he gave you?
A.119	Yes sir.
