

MINUTES OF THE PROCEEDINGS OF THE BAY OF QUINTE  
CONFERENCE OF THE METHODIST  
CHURCH,

HELD IN THE TOWN OF BOWMANVILLE, ONTARIO, COMMENCING  
ON THURSDAY, JUNE 3RD, 1897.
