

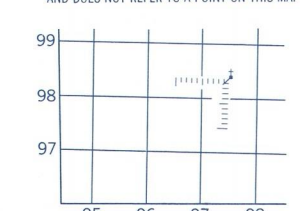

REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (as above)
EASTING: Read number on grid line immediately to left of point.	97
Estimate tenths of a square from this line eastward to point	$\frac{5}{975}$
NORTHING: Read number on grid line immediately below point.	98
Estimate tenths of a square from this line northward to point	$\frac{4}{984}$
