

SEMI-ANNUAL CONFERENCE
— OF THE —
MENNONITE CHURCH,
Of Waterloo County,

Held at Berlin, Ont., on September 13th, 1894.

The semi-annual conference of the Mennonite Church, of Waterloo Co., Ont., was held on the above date and place in the Christian Eby meeting-house. The conference was opened by singing and reading of Rom. 12. and prayer.

1.—*Resolved*, That a deacon be elected for the Conestogo Circuit. Acts 6: 1-8.

2.—*Resolved*, That we advise our brethren and sisters who are engaged in Sabbath School work, to walk as lights of the world, so that the young and rising generation can be won for the kingdom of Christ. Math. 5: 15-16.

3.—*Resolved*, That when brethren or sisters do not take part in the Inquiry and Sacrament, they shall be visited by the Minister and Deacon of that circuit and they shall deal with them according to circumstances. Math. 12: 30. Luke 13: 6-9.

Resolved, That the question which is asked to-day, relating to the rules and regulations of our burying grounds, shall be discussed at our next annual conference.

5.—*Resolved*, That Bro. Joseph Nahrgang and Bro. Menno Cressman visit our brethren and sisters in Berne, Huron county, Mich., this fall and winter. Math. 28: 20.
