## PRESBYTERIANS TO FIGHT UNION

The Objectors Have Formed Publishing Company With Capital of \$100,000

Special to The Standard. Ottawa, Mar. 30.—The activity of those members of the Presbyterian Church of Canada who are opposed to union with the Methodist and Congregational churches has begun to be very manifest and the latest move is the incorporation by Dominion charter of the "Presbyterian Church Association Publishing Company, Ltd." with headquarters at Toronto, and a capital stock of \$100,000. The incorporators include some of the most prominent Presbyterians in Canada and it is understood that they have behind them about one hundred thousand members of the Presbyterian Church who are opposed to union and the elimination of this essentially Scottish church. McGregor and Hon. R. M. McGregor, New Glasgow; John McKeen, Halifax; Rev. W. G. Brown, Red Deer; John C. Brown, New Westminster; Judge Hugh A. Robinson, Winnipeg; Judge A. G. Farrell, Moosemin, Sask., and James Galley, bank manager, Regina.
