

PROCEEDINGS

OF THE

Annual Meeting of the Society.

The THIRTY-SECOND ANNUAL MEETING of the MISSIONARY SOCIETY of the WESLEYAN METHODIST CHURCH IN CANADA, was held in Queen Street Church, Toronto, on Tuesday, December 15th, 1857. The Reverend RICHARD JONES in the Chair. The Meeting was opened with singing and prayer, and the Report having been read by the General Superintendent of Missions, the following Resolutions were adopted:—

- I. Moved by the Rev. L. O. RICE, seconded by PETER LE SUEUR, Esq.—

That the Report, of which an Abstract has been read, be received and printed, and circulated under the direction of the Committee.

- II. Moved by the Rev. J. BORLAND, seconded by J. McDONALD, Esq.—

That the increasing and animating success granted to this Society, the honoured Parent Society in Great Britain, and other Christian Missionary Institutions, calls for prompt and unreserved thanksgivings, and they are most devoutly offered by this Meeting to Him who is Head over all things to the Church.

- III. Moved by the Rev. G. DOUGLASS, seconded by the Rev. ANSON GREEN, D.D.—

That the supreme command of Christ, and the growing facilities of his people, the constant claims of existing Missions, and the urgent wants and solicitations of many unregenerate men in Canada, Hudson's Bay, and different Countries, render Divine energy indispensable, and make it the duty of all Churches to multiply their sympathies, prayers, and liberalities for the salvation of a world redeemed by the blood of the Lamb.

- IV. Moved by the Rev. J. H. BISHOP, seconded by the Rev J. LEAROYD.—

That this Meeting presents its sincere and hearty thanks to all the Ministers, Officers Collectors, and Contributors of all the Branch Societies, who have so effectually aided the Society, and earnestly entreats from its numerous adult and juvenile Friends, of all Religious Communities, a continuance and augmentation of their valuable services.
