

BILL.

An Act further to amend the law relative to the practice of Physic, Surgery and Midwifery, in Lower Canada.

WHEREAS it is inexpedient that any person should obtain a license to practise Physic, Surgery or Midwifery in Lower Canada, without undergoing an examination before the Provincial Medical Board: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

Preamble.

That the seventh section of the Act passed in the Session held in the tenth and eleventh years of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled, "An Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the study and practice of Physic and Surgery therein," shall be and is hereby repealed.

Sect. 7 of 10 & 11 Vict. c. 26 repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That for and notwithstanding anything in the said Act, or in the Act amending the same, passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's reign, and intituled, "An Act to amend the Act to incorporate the Members of the Medical Profession in Lower Canada, and to regulate the study and practice of Physic and Surgery therein," no person shall, after the passing of this Act, receive a license from the Provincial Medical Board to practice Physic, Surgery or Midwifery in Lower Canada, unless he shall have undergone an examination before the said Board, and obtained a certificate of qualification from the said Board: Provided always, that nothing in this Act shall apply to females practising midwifery in Lower Canada under the provisions of the Act first above cited.

No person to receive a license without examination, notwithstanding anything in the said Act, or in 12 Vict. c. 52.

Proviso.
