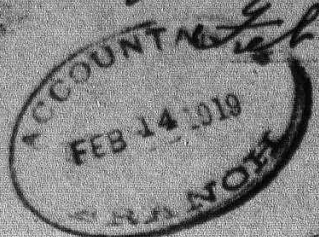

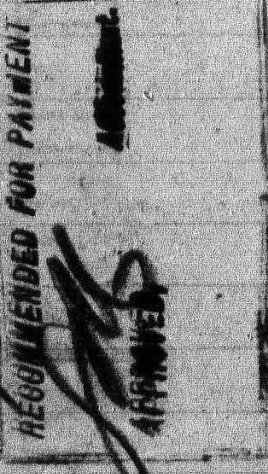
Sir,—
