So he kindled a Council fire at Fort Harmar, where near six hundred Indians of different Nations attended. The six Nations then renewed and confirmed the treaty of Fort Stanwix and the Wyandots and Delawareans renewed and confirmed the treaty of Fort McIntosh. Some Ottawas Chippewas Pottawatomies and Sac were also parties to this treaty of Fort Harmar.

Brothers. All the treaties we have here with us. We have also the speeches of many Chiefs who attended them, and who voluntarily declared their satisfaction with the terms of those treaties.
