of Muskingum. While he was waiting for them, some mischief happened at the place and the fire was put out. So he Kindled a Council fire at Fort Harmar, where near six hundred Indians of different Nations attended. The six Nations their renewed and confirmed the breaky of Fort Stanning and the Wyoudots and Deleward renewed and confirmed the treaty of Fort Me Intosto. Some Ollawais Chippewais Panta-watamies and lacs were also parties to this treaty Fort Hormar.
