April 3rd, 1936.

Committee Thirteen instructed by Council League follow Italo-Ethiopian dispute instructed Chairman and League Secretary General at last meeting held London March 24th get into touch with two parties and take such steps as called for to bring about cessation conflict within framework of League. Since then nothing further to relate concerning these steps but Secretary General is still receiving protests from both parties concerning events in war. Communication received April first from Ethiopian Government requesting League members furnish financial assistance, remove obstacles to transport of arms to Ethiopian troops, reinforce and complete sanctions required by Article Sixteen and request Italian Government respect International Conventions. Communication protests recent bombing Harrar.

Permanent Central Opium Board considered report on statistics manufacture, import, consumption, transformation of opium and other drugs and on seizures in illicit traffic.

Special Committee on Reform of Statute League communications and transit organization met at Geneva, Chairman (Krbec ?) Chairman of Advisory Technical Communications Transit Committee and held preliminary discussion.

Secretary General League sent Governments States Members and non-Members League elaborate programme prepared by special committee communications transit organization concerning measures that should be taken to bring into operation and effective international system signals at level crossings. Governments asked to say whether think proposed system might form
