I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant, stating that Mr. Clark, teacher of the No. 2 School at Onswoken, has made application to you for a license to trade with the Indians under Section 42 of the Indian Act.

In reply I beg to say that Mr. Clark is hereby authorized to engage in dealings only of the nature referred to in your letter on the condition that all transactions he may make shall receive your approval!

This license may be revoked at any time without notice.
