I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 23rd ultimo, in regard to question of surrender by the Sarcee Indians of a portion of their Reserve, and in reply would say that if the Indians are willing and give their consent to pay you \$3000.00 for your services in conducting on their behalf the negotiations for the surrender of a portion of the Sarcee Reserve, upon such surrender being obtained, the Department sees no objection to its being paid.
