Sir,

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 21st instant in reference to assistance to Reuben Bull of the Whitefish Lake reserve, an ex-pupil of the Red Deer Industrial School.

In reply I beg to say that in view of your recemmendation you are hereby authorized to purchase for this
young man a yoke of oxen, a set of ox harness and a plow
at a total cost not exceeding \$137.00. These purchases
should be made at once so that payment can be made out of
the appropriation for the current fiscal year. Reuben
should be required to sign the usual agreement and a copy
should be forwarded to the Department to be placed on
record.

I have to call your attention to the fact that the report asked for in official letter of the 24th ultimo has not yet been received. The Department must insist on receiving this at an early date.
