Sir,

I have the honor to inform you that the following instructions have been issued by the Treasury Board, and approved by His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1886; and to request you to conform thereto.

1. The per diem allowance for maintenance, is not hereafter to be paid to Officers in the employ of the Government, while travelling on Government business, for days spent on board steamers, or steamships, or other modes of conveyance, if the passage-money include meals and all other accommodation.
2. All advances made to such Officers, for travelling expenses, shall be accounted for, within one month from the conclusion of the trip; and the Officer shall render, through this Office, to the Department of Indian Affairs, for transmission to the Auditor General, a detailed statement of such travelling expenses.
