FIRST CHARGE

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE COMMITTING A CIVIL OFFENCE, THAT IS TO SAY, STEALING

in that he

in Brussels on the 27 November 44 did steal money in the amount of approximately 400 Belgian Francs, a cigarette case, a cigar case, a razor and blades, a pair of gloves, a watch, a handkerchief, a comb and a tube of toothpaste, the property of Mr. Edward Simon, and a compact and nail file, the property of Mme Gustavie Simon, both of 29A rue Edgar Tinel, Brussels.

SECOND CHARGE

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE BEING IN ARREST OR CONFINEMENT, ESCAPING

in that he

at approximately 1820 hours on 23 November 44, whilst in lawful custody undergoing detention at No.1 Field Punishment Camp and Detention Barracks, escaped.

THIRD CHARGE
Sec 15 (1)
Army Act

WHEN ON ACTIVE SERVICE ABSENTING HIMSELF WITHOUT LEAVE

in that he

absented himself without leave from No.1 Field Punishment Camp and Detention Barracks from 1820 hrs 23 November 44 until apprehended in Brussels by the Canadian Provost Corps at 2200 hours on the 27 November 44.

Time of absence 4 days, 3 hours, 40 minutes.
