

cide all questions of order and if any member be dissatisfied therewith she shall have the right to appeal to the Society.

ARTICLE XII.

Amending the Constitution.

The Constitution shall not be amended or altered except at a quarterly meeting.

The consent of three-quarters of the members present at such meeting shall be necessary to ratify an amendment, and notice of all proposed amendments shall be given in writing at the previous meeting.

The foregoing copy of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Scottish Ladies' Society of Vancouver was read and duly accepted at a meeting held in the Jewish Community Centre, Oak Street, Vancouver, on the evening of October 2nd, 1933.
