The Children at School—Altogether about 500 children are enrolled in these schools and to them we look for the best results in the work. Each child is signed into a Boarding School until the age of 18, unless in case of sickness that is infectious. Formerly some of the children were infected with tubercular trouble before coming into the school on account of their manner of living on the reserve, but this has greatly decreased owing to improved sanitary arrangements. The Government give proper medical inspection and have already placed qualified nurses in some of the Boarding Schools.

The Indian boys and girls learn to love their schools long before they are graduated. They study the regular public school course, and when they reach the higher classes, the girls must take their
