Students at Law, for the profession of Advocate, Attorney, Solicitor and Counsel, who served during the late war with the United States of America."

The House divided upon the question:

Yeas 13 Nays 8

So it was carried in the affirmative, and

RESOLVED, accordingly.

ORDERED, That Mr. Ogden do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.

An engrossed Bill, to authorise a Census, and Statistical Returns of the Province of Lower-Canada, was read for the third time.

Mr. Gugy, seconded by Mr. Panet, moved to resolve, that the Bill do pass, and that the Title be, "An Act to authorise a Census, and Statistical Returns of the Province of Lower-Canada."

The House divided upon the question:

Yeas 11 Nays 7

So it was carried in the affirmative, and

Resolved, accordingly.

Ordered, That Mr. Gugy do carry the Bill to the Legislative Council, and desire their concurrence.
