Among the laxatives are figs, prunes, dates, nectarines, oranges and mulberries. The astringents are blackberries, dewberries, raspberries, pomegranites, quinces, pears, wild cherries, cranberries and medlars.

The kinds of fruits used for diuretics are grapes, black currants, peaches, whortleberries and prickly pears. The refrigerants are red and white currants, gooseberries, lemons, limes and apples.

For improving shabby leather chairs take a pint of linseed oil, boil it and let it stand till nearly cold, then stir in half a pint of vinegar. Stir till thoroughly mixed, then bottle for use. When required shake the bottle well, pour a very little on the soft flannel cloth rub thoroughly into the leather, turning the flannel as it gets dirty; then rub with a soft duster till the polish of the leather is restored. This polish softens the leather and prevents it from cracking.
