

BIG REDUCTION IN WAGE ROLL

St. Thomas Department Pay-roll of M. C. R. To Be Lowered \$243,500.

ST. THOMAS, June 1.—The proposed wage reduction in the railway service if accepted by the local force will mean an annual reduction of earnings in the St. Thomas departments of the M. C. R. of \$243,500, on the G. T. R. Wabash \$50,000, and Pere Marquette \$100,000. These figures are based on the cut of twelve per cent, recently made by the Railroad Labor Board at Chicago. Master Mechanic Webb, M. C. R., returned from Detroit last evening without bringing back any definite news as to the results of the employees' and officials' conference in that city. Mr. Webb states that the reductions of twelve per cent will apply to the highest as well as the lowest paid railwayman in the service. The master mechanic had no probabilities to offer on the labor situation.

Mr. Webb did not see a return to old-time conditions, or a change in the labor situation. The new wage schedule becomes of general acceptance. The railway employees in the local departments will be guided by the decision of the representatives in Detroit.

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MOORE TOWNSHIP

IS SEEKING HYDRO

Application for Power Is Made To the Ontario Commission.

SARNIA, June 1.—One by one the rural municipalities of the county of Lambton are lining up for hydro power. At the regular meeting of the Moore Township Council a resolution was adopted that the municipal council make application to the hydro power commission for transmission and supply to the corporation of electrical power for the use of the corporation and its inhabitants for lighting, heating and power purposes. The formal resolution reads as follows: "Moved by Miller, seconded by Edwards, that the municipal council of the township of Moore, hereby make application to the hydro power commission for transmission and supply to the corporation of electrical power or energy for the use of the corporation and its inhabitants for lighting, heating and power purposes or for any or either of such purposes."

Members of the Sarnia Township Council have previously made informal overtures to the local and provincial commission as to the possibilities of securing a supply of power at an early date and an estimate of the cost of same.

COL. ALLISON FILES TO COLLECT COMMISSION

Suit For \$300,000 Was Unsuccessful But Will Be Appealed.

OTTAWA, June 1.—A local paper today prints a news item which says: "Col. John Wesley Allison, who became famous here during the war in connection with the investigation of war contracts by the Meredith-Duff Commission was unsuccessful recently in an action brought by him against the Remington Small Arms Company, for \$300,000 commission which he claimed was due him for services rendered in connection with the company from the British Government."

The case was heard during May in the supreme court of the State of New Jersey. It is understood here that Mr. Allison will appeal the case.

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STRAWBERRIES DROP

10 CENTS PER BOX ON LOCAL MARKET

Large Quantities Disposed Of At 35 Cents Per Box.

30 CENTS WHOLESALE

Live Hogs Selling At \$8 Per Hundredweight.

Heavy supplies of strawberries at the local market on Thursday morning were responsible for a drop of 10c a box retail and 5c on the wholesale quotations.

Blackberries now selling at 35c per box retail and 30c wholesale.

Even though there were large supplies, there was a fairly good demand, as the quality was good.

Oats sold at \$18.25 per cwt., and 47c per bushel.

Lettuce sold at 50¢ per dozen, while radishes were in good demand at 40¢ per dozen.
