**A SHORTAGE OF 30,000,000 LBS.**  
The Tea Business, like nearly every thing else, has been having its hard times since the war. Unfavorable tea growing weather, labor troubles on the plantations, and the unsettled political atmosphere generally, have seriously reduced this year's crop that the world is now faced with a shortage of over 30,000,000 lbs., or about one-third the supply for the whole Dominion of Canada. The inevitable result has been steadily increasing prices, until today tea is bringing higher prices than ever before in the history of the industry. **REARING THE CALF.**  
(Part Two.)  
We will assume now that the breeding we have been properly done, and that we have the calf ready to feed. From birth to weaning the whole question is one of development. How can the calf be fed and handled so as to make the most valuable cow? The answer to that question is largely concerned with the matter of feed. If the calf is properly fed development should be rapid and satisfactory. It should not be necessary to take the calf to the importance of developing size and feeding capacity in the young heifer. If we study good producing cows we will find that they are all of a type, and that whether or not they have actually been big cows they have always been big eaters. It is absolutely true that the growth is obtained for less feed when the calf is young than at any other time. A given amount of much growth from birth to one year old as it will produce from one to two years old. This shows the economy
