Clinical Instruction is given at the New York Hospital daily, by the Medical Officers, (Professor Smith being one of them.) fee \$8 per annum; at the Bellevue Hospital tal twice a week, without fee, (Professor Parker and Clark belonging to the Medical Staff;) at the Eye Infirmary, without fee; and upwards of 1000 patients are annually exhibited to the class in the College Clinique. Obstetrical cases and subjects for dissection are abundantly furnished through the respective department.

The Annual Comprencement is held at the close of the Session; there is also a Semi-annual Examination on the second Tuesday of September. The pre-requisites for Graduation are-21 years of age, three years of Study, including two full Courses of Lectures, the last of which must have been attended in this College, and the presentation of a Thesis on some subject connected with Medical Science.

In addition to the regular Course, and not interfering with it, a Course of Lectures will be commenced on Monday; 27th September, and continued until the 10th
